

The Backyard Summer Olympics - 2016 Rules

Bags Rules

Each player will throw all 8 bags and they will throw 4 separate rounds. They will use the highest point total from their best round. Scoring: 3 points for in the hole and 1 point for on the board. Bouncing onto the board awards zero points.

Flippy Cup Rules

Each player will flip 10 cups. They will flip 4 separate rounds. They will use the highest point total from their best round. Scoring: will get one point for each successful flip. Can only use one hand, other hand can't touch cup while flipping.

Pong Rules

Each player will throw 8 ping pong balls into set up of 10 cups. They will play 4 separate rounds. They will use the highest point total from their best round. Scoring: each successful throw into cup awards one point. Bounces count as well.

Darts Rules

Each player will throw 3 darts. Any darts that do not stick in the board will be re-thrown. They will throw 4 separate rounds. They will use the highest point total from their best round. The single Bulls eye is worth 25 and the double Bulls eye is worth 50.

Scoring for each event

Based on the total number of players weekly, the highest point totals will be awarded most points and down. For example: If there are 10 players, the person with highest point total will be awarded 10 points, second highest point total 9 points, 3rd highest point total 8 points, etc. If there is a tie, for instance 2nd and 3rd highest tie, total of 9 and 8 points available, each player will receive 8.5 pts.

Final scoring

Add up total points awarded for each of 4 the categories to gain final score. Example: 10 points bags, 3 points darts, 2 points flippy cup and 7 points beer pong = 22 total points. The person with the highest point total will win for that night.

Weekly Cost and Payouts

\$10 per person per night. Payouts as follows:

20% to Men's Highest Score

20% to Women's Highest Score

10% to Individual High Score per Event (40% total)

20% to Overall High Score Amongst All Players.
